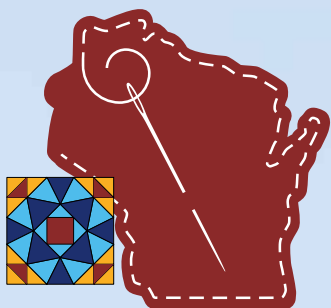

MATERIALS:

[1] AWISH Panel

1-1/2 yards Words Brick, includes Binding

3/4 yard Words Tan

1/2 yard Words Orange

1/3 yard Flags Brick

2-1/2 yards fabric of choice, Backing

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Corner Curve Quilts 4x2 Half Rectangle Acrylic Template [CCQ4X2HR]

Corner Curve Quilts 2x2 Half Square Triangle Acrylic Template [CCQ2X2HST]

BEFORE SEWING, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS. ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. PRESS SEAMS OPEN TO REDUCE BULK. MAKE A TEST BLOCK TO VERIFY ACCURATE CUTTING AND SEWING. IF USING A DIFFERENT METHOD, VERIFY YARDAGE, THE SIZE TO CUT FABRIC AND METHOD TO CREATE THE UNITS. HST - HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES, WOF - WIDTH OF FABRIC, HR - HALF RECTANGLES, QST - QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE.

CUTTING:

From AWISH Panel:

Fussy cut [1] - 24-1/2" square **(D)**

From Words Brick Fabric:

Cut [3] - 4-1/2" x WOF strips

Subcut [64] - 4-1/2" x 2-1/2"; using fabric right side up, use [CCQ4x2HR] template HR **(C4)**

Cut [6] - 2-1/2" x WOF strips

With using fabric right side up, use [CCQ2x2HST] template to cut [32] HST **(A)**

Subcut [4] - 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" rectangles **(E)**

Cut 2-1/2" bias strips to equal 190", Binding

From Words Orange Fabric:

Cut [3] - 2-1/2" x WOF strips

With using fabric right side up, use [CCQ2x2HST] template to cut [68] HST **(A)**

From Words Tan Fabric:

Cut [3] - 4-1/2" x WOF strips

With fabric right side up, use [CCQ4x2HR] template to cut [64] HR **(C4)**

Cut [2] - 2-1/2" x WOF strips

With fabric right side up, use [CCQ2x2HST] template, to cut [36] HST **(A)**

From Flags Brick Fabric:

Cut [2] - 4-1/2" x WOF strips

Subcut [16] - 4-1/2" squares **(B)**

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Half Square Triangle

1. Arrange [1] Words Brick 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A)** with [1] Words Orange 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A)**. Sew. Press. Make [32] Words Brick/ Words Orange 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A/A)**.
2. Arrange [1] Words Tan 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A)** with [1] Words Orange 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A)**. Sew. Press. Make [36] Words Tan/ Orange 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A/A)**.

Half Rectangle

1. Arrange [1] Words Brick **(C4)** with [1] Words Tan **(C4)**, on the long side of the triangles as shown. Sew. Press. Make [64] Words Brick/ Words Tan 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" HR **(C4/C4)**.



Twisted Churn Dash Block

1. Arrange [2] Words Brick/ Words Orange 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A/A)**, [2] Words Orange/ Words Tan 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" HST **(A/A)**, [4] Words Brick/ Words Tan 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" HR **(C4/C4)** and [1] Flags Brick 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" square **(B)** to assemble the blocks as shown.



Note the Words Brick **(C4/C4)** is touching the square Flag Brick **(B)** on the top and bottom of the block. The Words Tan **(C4/C4)** is touching the square Flag Brick **(B)** on the sides. Sew. Press. Make [16] — 8-1/2" square Twisted Churn Dash blocks **(TCD)**.

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Left and Right Twisted Churn Dash Border:

1. Arrange [3] — 8-1/2" square **(TCD)** blocks as shown. Sew blocks together. Press. Measures 8-1/2" × 24-1/2" unfinished. Make [2].
2. Sew borders to the left and right sides of the AWISH Panel **(D)** as shown. Press.



Top and Bottom Twisted Churn Dash Borders:

3. Arrange [5] — 8-1/2" square **(TCD)** blocks as shown. Sew. Press. Make [2].



4. Sew borders to the top and bottom of the AWISH Panel **(D)** as shown.



BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Arrange [2] Words Brick 2-1/2" × 40-1/2" **(E)**, to each side of the Panel unit, as shown.



2. Arrange [1] Words Brick 2-1/2" × 40-1/2" **(E)** in between [2] Words Tan/Words Orange 2-1/2" HST **(A/A)** as shown. Sew. Press. Make [2].



3. Sew units from Step 3 to the top and bottom with the Words Tan triangle to the outside as shown. Press.



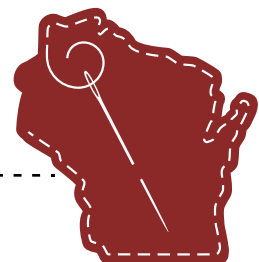
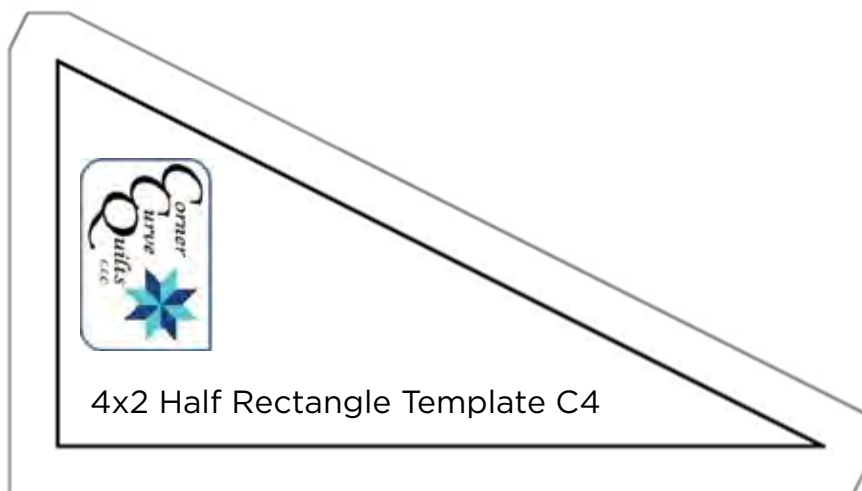
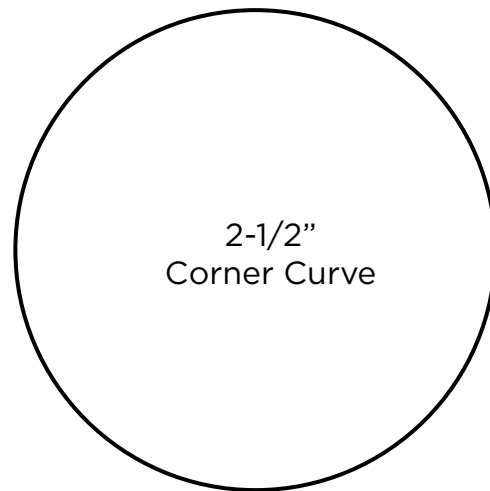
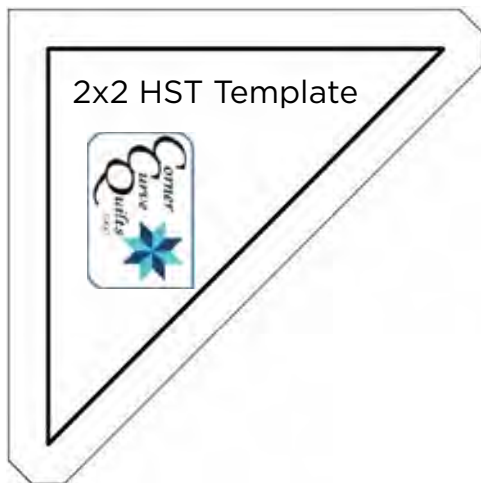
FINISHING:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Round all [4] corners of the quilt by positioning the 2-1/2" circular template in each corner and cutting around the outer edge.
4. Bind with bias binding.
5. Label and enjoy!
